

New Horizons Privacy Statement

New Horizons for New Hampshire places a high priority on protecting your privacy. This privacy policy was created in order to demonstrate New Horizons for NH commitment to the privacy of our donors, volunteers, and website users. This policy explains what type of information is collected by our website, www.newhorizonsnh.org, and how this information is used.

What Personally Identifiable Information (PII) is Collected

Those that sign up to receive New Horizons for NH e-communications voluntarily provide us with contact information (such as name and e-mail address). We may use this information for specific, limited purposes. You may always "opt out," either now or at any time in the future, if you do not wish to receive our messages.

Use and Disclosure of Personally Identifiable Information

If you do provide us with PII for an activity or event, we may use it to conduct such activity or event and future New Horizons for NH activities that may be of interest to you. We may contact you based on the information you provide online or offline. We will use our best effort to never disclose any PII about you to any third-party for purposes unrelated to New Horizons for NH without having received your permission except as provided for herein or otherwise as permitted or required under applicable law.

We do not rent or sell PII to third-parties. We may share PII with trusted service providers that need access to your information to provide operational or other support services.

We may also provide PII to regulatory authorities and law enforcement officials in accordance with applicable law or when we otherwise believe in good faith that the provision of such information is required or permitted by law, such as in connection with the investigation or assertion of legal defenses or for compliance matters.

How Your Information May Be Used

We use your personal information to provide you with personalized service; to send e-mail alerts to you; to answer your requests; to process your event registrations; etc. We may also use your information to track visitors of our website. This lets us see which of our features are the most popular so we can better serve our users' needs.

Choices You Have

You can quickly and easily opt-out of email communications using the the opt-out feature in any email that we send you. Alternatively, contact us at development@newhorizonsnh.org or 603-668-1877 to opt-out of receiving all or select future communications.

You have the option to request that your information be kept anonymous in our databases and mailing lists. You may also request to receive an annual letter identifying your calendar year contributions in the first month of each new year. This may be chosen in addition to or in replacement of individual donation acknowledgment/receipt letters.

Collection of Non-Personally Identifiable Information

- **IP address tracking:** An IP address is a number that is assigned to your computer when you are on the Internet. When you request pages from our Sites, our servers log your IP address.

- **“Cookie” technology:** A cookie is an element of data that a website can send to your browser, which may then store it on your system to help enhance your experience in using our sites and to provide us with technical information about your usage.
- **Web beacons:** A web beacon, or “clear gif,” is a small graphic image on a webpage or web-based document that a website can use to determine information about a user.

Non-personally identifiable information might include the browser you use, the type of computer you use, technical information about your means of connection to our websites (such as the operating systems and the Internet service providers utilized), and other similar information. Our systems may also automatically gather information about the areas you visit and search terms you utilize on our website and about the links you may select from within the sites to other areas of the World Wide Web or elsewhere online.

Information from Children

New Horizons for NH does not seek to collect personal information about children. If a child submits information, and New Horizons for NH is aware that the user submitting the information is a child, the information is not used for any purpose. New Horizons for NH will comply with all regulations set forth by the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA). To learn more about COPPA, visit the [Federal Trade Commission](#).
